If you are aged 18-65 with specific long-term conditions and/or in the 'at risk group' you will receive a text (or letter), asking you to <u>book an appointment on our website using</u> <u>Engage-Consult</u>: These include chronic respiratory disease or asthma, heart disease, renal disease, liver disease, diabetes, neurological disease, BMI > 40 or you are immune-suppressed, or a carer for an elderly or disabled person.

You will receive specific detail of what to wear and other guidance.
