The standard installation is a 10 panel 3.6 kWp system usually suited to a 3-Bed house, but the package you need depends on your consumption of electricity, not just your house size, so we also offer smaller and larger systems as well as add-ons like batteries and iBOOST to heat water with an immersion heater.
