Our line has been advanced in these localities, and prisoners have been captured by us.

Paris, Friday.—The special military correspondent of the Central News says that the Germans on the Champagne front—where General Gourand's army attacked—was on their guard, and had concentrated considerable forces and brought up picked troops. The Germans had organised their front on defensive methods which they had prepared, and consequently all the enemy precautions were in vain.
