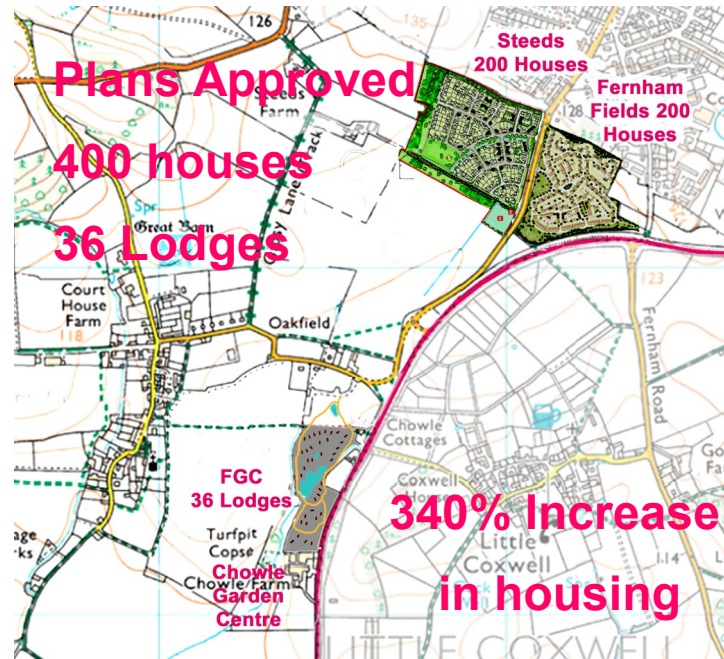

## Great Coxwell Community Led Plan

Topics extracted from 2013 Neighbourhood Plan Questionnaire (84% response) can now be shown within the scope of a Community Led Plan.

#### 1.What provides your quality of life in Great Coxwell?

rural location	79 (94%)
quiet	77 (92 %)
character of environment	70 (83%)
safety	61 (73%)
small supportive community	69 (82%)

#### 2.What changes could improve the village and parish?

facilities for the young/disabled	24 (29 %)
starter homes	20 (24%)
a shop	36 (43%)
cycle paths	21 (25%)
maintenance of parish footpaths-	56 (67%)
better facilities for village activities-	23 (29%)
