Funds are avialable in the Parish Accounts to meet these liabilities in full,.

It was discovered during the preparation of the accounts (in June/July 2019) that the repair to the Reading Room will be met by insurance and therefore the £5k grant from the County Council is not needed and is to be returned. An allowance for this money was ring-fenced in the 2018-9 Parish Council accounts and will be transferred to the Parish Room before repayment.

In March 2019 it was discovered that there had been a long-standing water leak under the Reading Room and a bill for £13,964.42 was received from the supplier. This figure was erroneously based on anticipated future usage (should the leak remain unrepaired), and drainage. Correcting the figure to allow for these two factors, It is likely that the liability would not exceed £5k. Liability for his leak is in dispute with the supplier and, although it is unlikely, potentially the council might be expected to pay the full amount (c. £14k). The Parish Council is aware of the liability and has committed to underwrite the debt. Sufficient funds are available within the Parish Council bank account to meet the likely maximum cost (£14k) or the more likely cost (£5k). A note regarding the potential £5k liability for the water leak was made to the Parish Council annual accounts for 2018-9.
